- The counting rules for the OASIS Outcome measures will be modified. In short:
 - > The existing counting rules will be retained to accommodate the transition for services.
 - > New counting rules will be introduced for Cases created on or after 1st July 2019:

OM2.1.01 Number of Service Users that have shown improvements in being safe and/or protected from harm	The counting rule will look to the FRE and Final FRRE rather than the <i>Family Safety</i> Domain within the Wellbeing Domains Assessments.
OM2.1.08 Number of Service Users with improved life skills	The counting rule will look to the <i>Initial</i> and <i>Closing</i> FAST Assessments with consideration for the <i>Parenting</i> Domain.

From 1st July, *Initial* Wellbeing Domain Assessments are no longer available.
